



## EASY APPLICATION

Must be used straight from the container with no mixing or dilution. Shake well.

Should be applied immediately after trimming or pruning.

Can also be applied to old wounded surfaces, but may not be effective against prior diseases and infestations.

Is usually applied using a brush. However, for treating very large areas or bushes, a garden sprayer is suggested to increase application efficiency.

Two or three applications are required, with each application being applied at 5 minute intervals.

Can be sprayed over the entire plant if necessary to achieve proper coverage and cannot harm any plants including your lawn.

Coverage is 100 sq. ft. per gallon per coat.

## EASY CLEAN UP

Clean brushes or sprayers with soap and water.

## LIMITATIONS

Do not use under windy conditions to avoid overspray. Do not apply to glass, brick, tile, aluminum or auto finishes. In case of accidental contact, it should be washed off as soon as possible with warm soapy water to prevent scratching. To remove from glass, use warm soapy water and a razor blade type scraper (always be careful when using sharp objects). To remove from auto finishes, use soapy water and then auto polish.

## SAFETY:

If ingested, rinse mouth with water and do not take antacids. For skin contact, wash with soap and water. For eye contact, flush eyes for 15 minutes under running water.
